








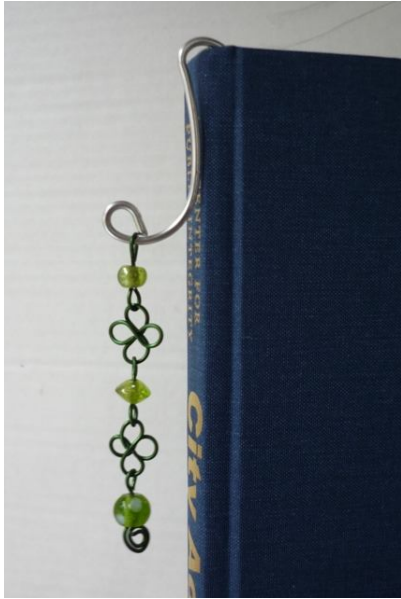


~~Wire Bookmarks Tutorial~~

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|  | <p>Supplies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 15 cm-20 cm of dead-soft wire, 12-14 gauge - assorted colours of 20 gauge dead-soft wire - assorted beads and charms - round-nose and flat-nose pliers |
|  | <p>Step 1 Take the 15 cm piece of thick wire and bend a loop at one end.</p> |
|  | <p>Step 2 About 5 cm from the loop, bend the wire to form a rounded "V"</p> |
|  | <p>Step 3 At the other end, form another loop. Wrap the wire around this first loop to form a flat spiral.</p> |

|  | <p>Step 4 This is “hook part” of the bookmark. It should resemble a music-note shape.</p> |
|  | <p>Step 5 Use the 20 gauge wire to form two clover shapes.</p> |
|  | <p>Step 6 Begin forming the clover shape by making a small loop. Then create another loop to form an “8” shape. Then form the third loop and fourth loop. Trim the ends.</p> |
|  | <p>Step 7 Cut three 5 cm lengths of 20 gauge wire. Form a loop at the end of each wire. Thread beads onto wire and finish the other ends with a loop.</p> |
|  | <p>Step 8 Using the loops, join the clover shapes and beads together to form a long chain.</p> |

**Connect chain to bookmark hook.
That's it! Now it's time to find a good
home for the bookmark.**
