





## ~~East Indian-Inspired Earrings Tutorial~~

	<p>Supplies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 2 ear wires</li> <li>- 2 jump rings</li> <li>- 16 seed beads</li> <li>- 8 4mm beads</li> <li>- 4 semi-precious beads</li> <li>- 4 x 8 cm 24 gauge copper wire</li> <li>- 2 x 12 cm 20 gauge copper wire</li> <li>- Wire jig</li> <li>- Wire cutters, flat-nose pliers, round-nose pliers</li> </ul>
	<p>Step 1</p> <p>Arrange the pegs on the wire jig as shown.</p> <p>Make a loop at one end of a piece of 20G copper wire, then place onto the bottom peg and wrap wire around pegs as shown.</p>
	<p>Step 2</p> <p>Squish the sides of your frame in, using round-nose pliers if necessary to give it a nice shape.</p> <p>Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the other piece of 20G wire.</p>

	<p>Step 3</p> <p>Make a spiral at the end of a piece of 24 G wire by using the round-nose pliers to start, then going around with flat-nose pliers.</p>
 <p>seed bead</p> <p>4 mm bead</p> <p>semi-precious</p> <p>make the spiral before threading any beads on</p> <p>make a loop at the end</p>	<p>Step 4</p> <p>Thread beads on as shown, then finish with a loop.</p> <p>Make three other dangles the same way.</p>
 <p>ear wire</p> <p>jump ring</p> <p>frame</p> <p>dangles</p>	<p>Step 5</p> <p>Assemble your earrings! Use the jump ring to secure the frame to the ear wire.</p>
	<p>Step 6</p> <p>Enjoy your new earrings!</p>
