## Supplies: 2 ear wires 2 jump rings 16 seed beads 8 4mm beads 4 semi-precious beads 4 x 8 cm 24 gauge copper wire 2 x 12 cm 20 gauge copper wire Wire jig Wire cutters, flat-nose pliers, round-nose pliers Step 1 Arrange the pegs on the wire jig as shown. Make a loop at one end of a piece of 20G copper wire, then place onto the bottom peg and wrap wire around pegs as shown. Step 2 Squish the sides of your frame in, using squish from both sides round-nose pliers if necessary to give it a nice shape. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the other piece of 20G wire.
